4) International candidates need not write the entrance examination. Admission will be based on marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

5) Applications will be scrutinized and eligibility candidates will be called for interview along with the parent.

6) Suitable candidates will be provisionally admitted and the fee can be paid.

7) Candidates can register their names by sending the copy of filled in application (with available data) through mail or post from November 2009 onwards. However the admission confirmation will be intimated to the candidates only after receiving the mark sheets. (copy of mark sheet / result / internet downloaded mark sheet or certificate to be forwarded to the Admissions Officer immediately after the announcement of results)

8) Eligibility :

i) A pass in 10+2 or equivalent examination in first attempt with 60% marks aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Maths. 60% in Maths is compulsory.

(OR)

ii) 55% in any of the following foreign examinations:

- 12 years Baccalaureate Certificate of Afghanistan, France, Iraq and Tunisia.
- 12 years General Secondary Education Certificate of the Ministry of Education – Bahrain, Egypt, Iran, Jordan, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and other Gulf countries.
- GCE/IGCSE/GCSE examinations of the approved British Examining Bodies in UK, Singapore, Hong Kong, and Mauritius with passes in 5 subjects at 'Ordinary Level' and 2 subjects at 'Advanced Level'. For admission to professional courses – medical/engineering Advanced level passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Mathematics and English are essential besides 5(Five) passes at GCE 'Ordinary Level'.
- High School Diploma from accredited School of USA.
- Intermediate/Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary of the approved Boards in Pakistan, Bangladesh and Nepal.
- 12 years Secondary stage qualification of National Examination Board/Council of the Ministry of Education – Kenya, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Sudan, Uganda and Tanzania.
- 12 years Secondary Stage Examination conducted by various Provinces in Australia and Canada

- GCE ‘Ordinary and Advanced’ level examination of the Department of Examination, Government of Sri Lanka
- 12-years STPM examination of Malaysia
- 12-years Secondary Stage qualification of Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Socialist Republic of Vietnam and Yemen Arab Republic,.
- ‘Abitur ‘ of Germany
- 12-year High School Diploma awarded by the accredited American School/International Schools in other countries following American pattern of education.

(They have to submit an Equivalence certificate obtained from “Association of Indian Universities, AIU House, 16 Comerade Indrajit Gupta Marg, New Delhi – 110002.)

10) Guidelines for International students wanting to pursue the programmes with Karunya University:

- Mutual exchange of students and faculty with Valparaiso University, USA is visualized. Under this programme, students can pursue a short duration course/project at Karunya University in any one of the disciplines offered by that University and the credits earned will be considered for the award of Karunya University degrees.
- Students of Valparaiso University may also pursue a short term summer programme project at Karunya University for which credits awarded will be considered by Valparaiso University for

the award of its degree. In both instances no fee will be charged. The students will continue to pay the fees at their own Institution and the living expenses will also be paid at their own Institution. The exchanges will be mutual with cost being set off mutually. Students will only have to bear the travel and food cost.

- Dual teaching / Twin teaching of selected Staffordshire University courses at Karunya University, some of them on-line where Karunya University will fix a designated fee.
- Dual Teaching / Twin teaching of selected Karunya University courses in areas of Water Management, Environmental Management to be offered on-line to students of Staffordshire University, who will pay fees to Staffordshire University as designated by Staffordshire University. Credits by the Board of Management of Karunya and the highest academic body of Staffordshire University.
